A Visit to “Ontake” :

A Handmade Soba Restaurant Inspired by Kiso’s Spring Water

Glossy, Fragrant, and Rich in Flavor Soba Made with Quantum Water

Can You Tell Its Taste Without Eating?

In November 2024, we visited “**Teuchi Soba Ontake**” located in Hisai, Tsu City, Mie Prefecture.

On the back of the business card of the second-generation proprietress, Ms. Yumiko Hirohashi, are listed three locations:

- *Iga Ueno (main store)*
- *Hisai*
- *Matsusaka*

Above them is written, “With unwavering dedication to authenticity.” Soba, even among dining establishments, is often said to have a certain refinement, a quiet threshold not easily crossed. Ms. Hirohashi herself acknowledged this. And yet, for a traditional handmade soba restaurant to openly declare such a philosophy, “authenticity above all” suggests a confidence that becomes immediately apparent through the atmosphere of the shop, its signage, and even its smallest details.

An Unusual Admission

To be candid, the visit took place on a closed day to avoid inconvenience to customers. As a result, the interview team left without actually tasting the soba. And yet, one somehow understands its excellence, even without tasting.

This impression was reinforced by Mr. Tsutomu Kagawa, director of LoveRon Co., Ltd., who operates **Asuka Swimming School** in Nara (see Chapter 6).

He had visited Ontake many times and spoke of it with conviction.

“There is a soba restaurant worth experiencing, you should visit.”

That restaurant was Ontake.

Quantum Water :Essential to Soba

The name “Ontake” is a tribute to the natural blessings of Mount Ontake in Kiso.

Ms. Hirohashi explains, *“Our main store in Iga Ueno has always been blessed with excellent water. We used natural spring water from Kiso, which paired perfectly with our soba flour.”* However, in recent years increasing seismic activity and changes in the earth’s structure raised concerns. It was during this period that she encountered **Quantum Water**.

A Recommendation That Led to Change

The introduction came through Mr. Kagawa.

“There’s a remarkable kind of water, you should try it.”

In 2020, vG7 was installed at the main water supply. At first, nothing visible changed. Ms. Hirohashi recalls, *“It began with a sense of anticipation and a bit of uncertainty. How would we explain this to our staff?”* Yet, the differences soon became apparent.

Maintaining Taste Rather Than Changing It

Regarding the most important element, the taste of the soba...she reflects thoughtfully.

“Our challenge is not to change the flavor, but to maintain it. In a difficult industry, the fact that we continue to operate as we do may itself be the answer.”

Texture, Aroma, and Subtle Transformation

Speaking of her impressions, she notes, *“Quantum Water has finer particles, so it penetrates the soba flour more easily. The softness feels different.”*

Craftsmen at the restaurant have also observed:

“The dough has a kind of luster now and the aroma when kneading is noticeably richer.”

From Kitchen to Daily Life

Today, all three Ontake locations are equipped with Quantum Water Systems. From any faucet, Quantum Water flows.

This has brought unexpected benefits.

- *reduced hand irritation among staff*
- *elimination of unpleasant odors*

Ms. Hirohashi has even installed five units in her own home and family residence.

A Personal Story

Her mother, now 80 years old, underwent surgery for stomach cancer. During recovery, she was given GuruGuru-Sui Quantum Water (reverse water) regularly. Four years later, she remains healthy and active, without recurrence.

An Atmosphere Beyond Taste

The Ontake restaurant offers more than comfort. There is a subtle clarity in the air, a sense of freshness that seems to permeate the space. Perhaps it is the warmth of the proprietress, or perhaps the presence of the water itself.

A Place Shaped by Fortune

Hisai was not originally a place of deep connection.

At the time of opening, the area consisted mainly of:

- *a hospital across the road*
- *a distant shopping center*

Today, it has become a vibrant central district. Ms. Hirohashi reflects: *“Only recently have customers begun to say, “Was Ontake’s broth always this delicious?”*

Looking Forward

Despite repeated closures during the COVID-19 period, the restaurant has now returned to pre-pandemic levels. The challenge ahead, she says, *“How to sustain this.”* In that effort, Quantum Water has become a reliable ally.

A Final Reflection

When asked, *“What does Quantum Water mean to you?”*

She smiled, then answered sincerely:

“It is something I always want to be by our side, like soba itself.”

Then, with gentle humor, “As a soba shop, we hope to remain close to people, long and enduring, just like soba noodles. (It is a gentle humor being that SOBA means close to in Japanese)”

Thanks to Quantum Water: No Lingering Smell, No Rough Hands which is Especially Appreciated by Female Staff

Have the Building’s Pipes Been Cleaned from Within?

Among popular television cooking shows, one cuisine consistently captures attention, **Yakiniku (grilled meat).**

Whether celebrities, idols, or athletes, when asked how they reward themselves, the answer often comes without hesitation, *“I want to eat Yakiniku!”*

Yet behind this popularity, the Yakiniku industry, like much of the restaurant world, exists in a constant cycle of rise and decline. From high-end establishments to chain restaurants and all-you-can-eat venues, the spectrum is vast, and the environment undeniably competitive.

In such a demanding field, a restaurant that continues operating for nearly twenty years is something of a rarity. Location, management skill, and culinary quality, many factors contribute to success.

In November 2024, we visited **“Koryu” in Shinsaibashi** to explore one of the lesser-known elements behind that longevity. We were welcomed by Mr. Tatsuhiro Matsui, President of **Max Super Dining Co., Ltd.**

His company operates:

- **Koryu Shinsaibashi**
- **Koryu Kitashinchi**
- **Koryu Hanare (Kitashinchi)**
- **Yakitori restaurant “Akiyoshi” Shinsaibashi**

What all four locations share is this: *every one of them uses vG7 quantum water.*

An Unexpected Phenomenon

The Shinsaibashi branch, the first to introduce Quantum Water 18 years ago, is located on the 8th floor of a multi-tenant building. Two to three months after installation, the building management company approached them: *“Have you installed some kind of equipment?”*

Concerned, Mr. Matsui asked why.

The answer was surprising:

“A sludge-like substance has been coming out of the building’s vertical pipes.” Because Koryu, on the top floor, was using Quantum Water, its drainage appeared to have loosened accumulated buildup within the pipes themselves.

Mr. Matsui reflects:

“I think it was proof that the pipes themselves had been cleaned.”

An effect far beyond ordinary expectations.

Eighteen Years Without Maintenance

Speaking of the differences after installation, Mr. Matsui explains:

“The first noticeable change was the reduction of hand irritation among staff. And then the smell.”

Yakiniku restaurants, by nature, use grill roasters.

Yet here, even during closing hours, the lingering odor of grilled meat is minimal.

This has had a significant impact on staff: “University students—especially female students, often avoid Yakiniku or Yakitori jobs because they don’t want their hair to smell after work.”

But at Koryu: *“There’s virtually no odor, so staff retention is high.”*

Proof Through Simple Experiment

Before adopting the system, they conducted a simple test: placing flowers in two vases:

- *one with tap water*
- *one with quantum water*

The difference was immediately visible. They also cultivate greenery on the balcony, with about 30 cm of soil. Mr. Matsui notes:

“Plants don’t usually grow this much on the 8th floor of a building.”

A Long Commitment to Water

With over 30 years in the food industry, Mr. Matsui had always paid attention to water quality.

Before quantum water, he had experimented with:

- *electrolyzed water*
- *hydrogen water*

Eighteen years ago, a trusted acquaintance a quantum water distributor, encouraged him: *“Why not try it once?”*

He did... And for 18 years:

- *no replacement of internal parts*
- *no running costs*
- *no maintenance required*

As he puts it: *“It’s nothing but advantages.”*

Cleanliness and Peace of Mind

Although not widely understood, Quantum Water has demonstrated significant antibacterial effects.

In official testing facilities, comparisons of cutting boards showed: *a clear difference between environments with and without quantum water systems.*

For Mr. Matsui, the most important benefit is simple:

“Peace of mind. Being able to use equipment safely, that’s everything.”

Quantum Water Used by a Brewery Where “Good Water” Is Everything

A Young Successor Takes the Helm

In December 2024, Japanese sake was officially registered as a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage.

Alongside this recognition, a global **SAKE boom** has emerged.

Yet domestically, production has steadily declined since its peak in 1973.

The Four Elements of Fine Sake

Traditionally, three elements define great sake:

1. *Water*
2. *Rice*
3. *The master brewer (toji)*

But a fourth, less obvious factor is sometimes added: **the character of the owner.**

Indeed, in any craft or business, the essence lies with the person behind it.

A Visit to Aoto Brewery

With this in mind, we visited **Aoto Brewery** in Yasugi City, Shimane Prefecture.

Founded in 1895, the brewery is located in a region rich in natural beauty and pure water. President Mikihiro Aoto, born in 1954, inherited the business at a young age after losing both his father and grandfather.

Returning to Traditional Methods

Facing challenges in the sake industry, Mr. Aoto returned to traditional techniques:

- *Shizuku-dori (drip extraction)*
- *Fune pressing (wooden press method)*

These methods:

- *apply gentler pressure*
- *reduce impurities*
- *enhance aroma and clarity*

The result is their signature series: *“Aoto Shichisei” (Blue Seven Stars). Named after the visual image of koji floating in water, like stars scattered across a night sky.*

A Brewery Built on Participation

At Aoto Brewery, everyone participates in production:

- *brewers*
- *office staff*
- *part-time workers*

This system has enabled:

- *a five-day workweek*
- *shared responsibility*

Their philosophy is simple:

“Making sake is about making people.”

The Role of Quantum Water

While already blessed with excellent natural water, the brewery introduced Quantum Water to enhance it further.

Mr. Aoto reflects: *“We want to create a softer sake. Quantum water seems to contribute to that softness and it likely affects fermentation as well.”*

Craft, Character, and Quiet Excellence

Balancing tradition and innovation, quality and scale, individual skill and collective effort. Aoto Brewery represents a quietly remarkable example of excellence. And perhaps reminds us: *there are still many hidden gems within Japan’s sake culture.*

Sake Lees Chocolate

A Byproduct Turned Treasure

At the brewery, one finds a unique product: *chocolate made with sake lees*.

Unlike machine-pressed lees, those from wooden pressing contain:

- *more residual sake*
- *softer texture*

What was once considered waste became inspiration.

Now available in:

- *white chocolate*
- *matcha chocolate*

Always made in-house.

As the philosophy goes: *“If we don’t make it ourselves, it has no meaning.”*

Even the master brewer helps with bottling and shipping.

Motto is, *“If we don’t believe it tastes good ourselves, we can’t serve it with sincerity.”*

The Secret of Flavor

In the end, the secret is not just technique but participation, care, and belief.

Chapter 6 Why Children Love Quantum Water

A Visit to “Asuka Swimming School” in Nara

A Pool Without the Smell of Chlorine

vG7 Quantum Water: Essential Not Only for Water Quality, but Also for Reducing Operating Costs

A Pool Without Odor, A Pool with Clear Water

On October 17, 2022, Wellness Co., Ltd. traveled to Nara with a professional film crew to shoot promotional video footage.

Asuka Swimming School is conveniently located in front of **Okadera Station** on the Kintetsu Yoshino Line, along National Route 169. In addition to the swimming school, the organization also operates:

- *a sports gym*
- *a cram school*
- *and other affiliated facilities*

Throughout the entire group, vG7 Quantum Water is in use.

The first thing one notices upon entering is that the distinctive chlorine smell normally associated with swimming pools is entirely absent.

Mr. Tsutomu Kagawa, director of **LoveRon Co., Ltd.**, the company that owns the facility, describes its defining feature as follows:

“First of all, the water is clean. There is none of the chlorine odor that is usually unavoidable in ordinary pools. The only thing that could account for that difference is vG7 Quantum Water.”

The 25-meter pool contains approximately **300 tons of water**.

According to Mr. Kagawa, the effect was visible almost immediately:

“The very next day after installation, the water had changed. Its clarity had noticeably improved.” Having struggled for many years with the treatment and maintenance of pool water, he was able to recognize the change at once.

Cloudiness in pool water is generally caused by:

- *bodily residue*
- *microbial contamination*

vG7 Quantum Water is known to suppress bacterial growth.

As referenced in the case of **Yuhara Onsen Fureai no Yu** in Yazu District, Tottori Prefecture (see Chapter 10), water quality tests there reported:
zero Legionella bacteria.

Nearly One Million Yen in Annual Cost Reduction

Chlorine and humidity are widely considered to be among the greatest enemies of building maintenance. Asuka Swimming School opened more than thirty years ago. Remarkably, aside from repainting the walls, much of the facility remains as it was originally built. Such durability is almost unheard of for a typical pool facility, and reflects the care invested in maintenance.

Before introducing vG7 Quantum Water, the school had first installed an ozone-generating system.

However:

- *maintenance costs were high*
- *its effectiveness diminished quickly*

They then moved to a system that electrolyzed liquid chlorine. While this did improve water quality, the machinery aged over time and its performance declined.

In addition, liquid chlorine was expensive. Including maintenance, monthly costs reached approximately ¥ 120,000.

It was at that stage that they decided to try **vG7 Quantum Water**.

Mr. Kagawa explains:

“At first, we continued using the expensive liquid chlorine. Later, we switched to ordinary solid chlorine, and found that the effect was exactly the same. That reduced our chlorine cost to one third, around ¥40,000 per month, which means nearly ¥1 million a year in savings. It has helped us tremendously.”

The reason he was willing to try vG7 in the first place was because he had already heard, from Dr. Shigenori Uda, the former Panasonic patent holder known for his salt-based farming method that using vG7 Quantum Water in agriculture had led to improved yields.

Later, Mr. Shuushi Nomura of Wellness visited the school and said:
“Please just try installing it. If you see results, you can pay us then.”

Mr. Kagawa admits he was initially skeptical.

Yet the effects were not only visible in the pool. He himself, who had previously suffered from skin irritation after swimming, noticed that his skin quickly began to feel better.

He reflects:

“Because our members use the pool every day, our environment has become normal to them, so they may not notice the difference as easily. But visitors from outside are always surprised by how clean the water is. The greatest differences are, after all, the cleanliness of the water and the absence of odor.”

The Odor of a Soba Restaurant’s Septic Tank Disappeared

Mr. Kagawa also described changes beyond the pool itself.

“What surprised us most was that the toilets used to have an ammonia odor, and that disappeared. Because vG7 is attached at the main water inlet, the entire building is supplied with quantum water. We clean the toilets with that water as well, so the ammonia seems to break down.”

After seeing that the restroom odor had disappeared, he mentioned it to an acquaintance who ran a soba restaurant in Mie Prefecture (see Chapter 5, **Handmade Soba Ontake**). That restaurant had been troubled by odor from its septic system.

He recommended a household vG7 unit. After trying it, the odor disappeared. And more than that, the taste of the soba improved.

Until then, the restaurant had been making regular trips to Mount Ontake to collect water for soba preparation. Since there were three locations, this required a tremendous amount of effort.

Mr. Kagawa then recommended the **GuruGuru Sui Hexagon 30** reverse water system for home use. When they tried making soba with it, the result was fully satisfactory. They no longer needed to travel to fetch mountain water, and were profoundly grateful.

Quantum Water Misting as a COVID Countermeasure

Like many commercial facilities, Asuka Swimming School also struggled during the COVID era with questions of infection prevention.

In response, the company introduced a commercial-use **Hexagon 30 (100L)** system for countermeasure purposes.

While considering how best to approach disinfection, they received information from Wellness regarding data from a Mexican alternative medicine institute (Mashac Alternative Medicine School), where vG7 Quantum Water was reported to have shown beneficial effects in more than **98% of COVID cases**.

Based on that report, they began placing **GuruGuru-Sui** (reverse water) into humidifiers and dispersing it as mist.

According to Mr. Kagawa, there were **no COVID infections within the facility**, including at affiliated gyms and cram schools, which he says was an enormous relief.

Of course, although vG7 Quantum Water requires virtually no maintenance cost, it is not a cheap purchase. It is natural to hesitate at first. Mr. Kagawa says: *“At first, I thought it might be expensive. But chlorine costs alone have dropped by nearly ¥1 million a year, so the initial investment has already paid for itself.”*

In addition, because the water remains cleaner:

- *filtration systems need to be used less often*
- *overall water consumption is reduced*

All in all, he considers it an excellent investment, and remains highly satisfied with the results.

A Popular Childcare Center with Eight Drinking Stations

Visiting Akiba Certified Children's Center

Operated by the Social Welfare Corporation Shuhari

Water Chosen for the Health of Children

On October 13, 2023, we visited **Akiba Certified Center for Early Childhood**

Education and Care, located in Totsuka, Yokohama, Kanagawa Prefecture.

The center is directed by **Mr. Shinichi Hidaka**.

Committed to providing safe water for the sake of children's health, the facility selected vG7 Quantum Water from among many available water systems. Today, quantum water flows throughout the entire building.

This water is used for:

- *drinking*
- *cooking*
- *summer pool activities*
- *toilets*

The center was formerly a public nursery school run by the City of Yokohama.

In 2004, the privatization of public nursery schools began, and in 2005 this center came under new management. In April 2019, it was formally reorganized as a certified integrated early childhood center.

Today, it cares for approximately **150 children**, from infants to five-year-olds, more than double the number enrolled during its public era.

When the transition first began, the center faced serious resistance. At one point, parents filed a lawsuit against Yokohama City, arguing that privatization would lead to a decline in the quality of care.

Even replacing a single old desk was reportedly difficult in those early days.

Yet, having overcome such headwinds, the center is now widely seen as offering a level of care far better than in its public-school days. And it appears that vG7 Quantum Water has played no small part in that transformation.

The parent organization of the center is the social welfare corporation **Shuhari**, based in Miyazaki Prefecture and led by **Mr. Fumitaka Ogasawara**. Facilities in Miyazaki had already introduced vG7 Quantum Water before this Yokohama center did.

An Annual Development Plan Designed Around Children's Growth

One of the defining features of **Akiba Certified Center for Early Childhood Education and Care** is its setting in a lush natural environment.

The three-story building includes three spacious playground areas, one on each of the first, second, and third floors. Children can play and exercise even on rainy days without getting wet, and there is also a large indoor hall.

If one steps out onto the natural wooden deck on the south side of the first floor, **Akiba Third Park** can be seen below.

The second floor is used as a pool area during the summer, and from the third floor, one can look out toward the town stretching to the seaside. Altogether, the environment has been carefully arranged so that children of different ages can learn through play while spending their days safely and in good health.

Regarding the center's emphasis on **movement and play**, a year-round program has been created so that children can naturally develop a balanced physical sense appropriate to their age.

Along the hallways, the walls were filled with annual teaching plans detailing age-appropriate activities in such areas as:

- *physical movement*
 - *cognitive development*
 - *nutrition*

The very name of the social welfare corporation, **Shuhari**, is itself distinctive. Originally, it seems, the chairman, who had practiced KENDO, applied a principle he had used both in martial arts and in daily life to the philosophy of the children's center as well.

The meaning of *shu-ha-ri* comes from the deeper principles of Japanese martial and artistic disciplines: *first, one learns the form; then, one introduces one's own ingenuity; and finally, one grows into one's individuality.*

In contemporary terms, it may be described as a kind of harmonious innovation.

Why They Hold Two Sports Festivals a Year

Even on the day of filming, children were practicing **stilts walking** barefoot in the playground, while in the classrooms others were happily drawing and playing.

At the entrance, samples of that day's school lunch were displayed, and throughout the hallways children's artwork had been carefully exhibited.

The lunches, too, reflect the center's attention to health.

At a time when childhood obesity has become an issue, the meals are centered on Japanese food, and even the broth is prepared without additives.

An original lunch program is not unusual in itself, but what was surprising was that the dining ware had been specially commissioned from a professional manufacturer so that it would be easier for small children to use.

As for the water considered suitable for health, the center's own website explains:
"A special water purification device is installed at the main water supply, allowing everyone in the facility to live with delicious, healthy, and safe water."

A photograph of the Wellness vG7 Quantum Water system is also displayed there.

Their annual calendar of events is full, but what sets this center apart from many other kindergartens and nursery schools is its approach to the sports festival. Ordinarily, such events are held around June or near Sports Day in October.

Here, however, the developmental process of the children comes first, and so there are **two sports events each year:**

- in October, a **Parent–Child Sports Day**, where parents and children move and play together
- in February, a **Movement Presentation Day**, where the children present the results of a year's worth of physical play and development

Indeed, rather than having children who have only just entered the center immediately begin practicing for a sports festival with unfamiliar people, it seems much more natural for them first to grow accustomed to the environment, to move together with their parents in autumn, and only later, in February, to hold what would traditionally be called the sports festival.

In terms of education, the center also cooperates with nearby elementary schools, providing opportunities for preschool children to interact with older students through exchange activities called **Nakayoshi-kai** ("Friendship Gatherings").

A single visit is enough to reveal the secret of this center's popularity.

Water That Allows Medaka Fish to Live Throughout the Entire Facility

This center seems to make full use of the flexibility and ingenuity possible precisely because it is privately operated rather than public.

Director **Shinichi Hidaka**, originally from Miyazaki, has served as the second director for the past eighteen years. As someone who appears in Wellness promotional interviews, he is also a devoted supporter of Quantum Water, having experienced its benefits in daily life.

Today, there are eight drinking stations throughout the premises, both indoors and outdoors. According to Director Hidaka, not only staff members but also parents of the children often fill their own empty bottles with the center's Quantum Water.

That, in itself, is evidence that people feel it is “delicious” and it is a “good water.” The thing that surprises visitors most, however, is the center’s raising of medaka fish. When prospective parents are told that medaka can be kept alive directly in the water that comes from the center’s faucets, without any dechlorination at all, they are invariably astonished.

Director Hidaka explains emphatically: *“The Medaka can be raised directly in the water that comes out of the children’s center tap. It seems impossible. If you use ordinary tap water as it is, small Medaka will die.*

Then what about children? Human beings are larger than Medaka, so perhaps they would not immediately become critically ill, but surely it still has some harmful effect on the body, doesn’t it?”

For Director Hidaka, this question carries deeply personal meaning. His wife was once diagnosed with malignant lymphoma, a cancer of the blood, and doctors had given them shocking information, including survival statistics. In the midst of that emotional anguish, the thing he turned to, almost in desperation, was vG7 Quantum Water, sent from the corporation’s headquarters by its chairman.

There have indeed been many testimonies of remission in cases of malignant lymphoma. As Director Hidaka puts it: *“By drinking this water, perhaps it became a kind of emotional support, something that eased fear and anxiety.”*

Today, his wife has recovered, returned to daily life, and resumed her work. Director Hidaka says simply: *“I’m glad we chose vG7 Quantum Water.”*

His hope extends beyond the children’s center itself: *“If possible, I hope for the day when the water coming from our taps will itself be vG7.”*

It is a quiet but powerful expression of his faith in the future of this water.

A Stay-Type Entertainment Mall Sending New Values Out into the World

The Birth of a Future-Oriented Entertainment Facility

Just after the May holidays in 2024, we visited the much-talked-about leisure facility **WHATAWON**, which had newly opened in Kishiwada, Osaka, under the leadership of President **Toshiyuki Hara**.

If traffic is light, it can be reached from Osaka in less than an hour by car. Across the road lies **Tonboike Park**, which reportedly welcomes around one million visitors annually.

With good access from Kansai International Airport as well, the location is highly promising and still has ample room to grow. The site itself covers an area roughly **twice the size of Koshien Stadium**.

True to its slogan:

“A life-sized extraordinary place, from morning to night”, it is conceived as “a special place where everyone can enjoy an entire day, from morning until evening.”

In other words, it is a **stay-type entertainment mall** that transcends genre and conventional categories of value.

Its original vision was to create a small town embracing everything related to:

- **fashion**
- **beauty**
- **music**
- **interiors**
- **architecture**
- **food**
- **lifestyle**

Since the founding of its parent company, **antiqua**, in 2008, this project had been imagined under a design philosophy described as:

“Creating what does not yet exist.”

That philosophy ultimately took shape as WHATAWON.

And because it truly is a place designed for staying, one quickly realizes that a single day is hardly enough. Whenever one visits, something new awaits:

- *something beautiful*
- *something delicious*
- *something interesting*
- *something stylish*

In the main shopping area, where fashion and apparel are central, there is a large merchandise zone called **WBOX**, as well as a trailer-style shopping area inspired by scenes seen in Britain.

There is also:

- *a vast food hall with many different vendors*
- *cafés*

- *a market specializing in popular products from Hokkaido*
- *event spaces for music festivals and more*
- *a generous dog run*
- *a camping area*
- *a skateboard park*
- *trailer houses for overnight guests*
- *simulation golf*
- *a beauty-and-lifestyle area including a hair salon, dental clinic, and relaxation services*

In short, it is a place where one could spend the entire day.

Various areas host:

- *workshops*
- *events related to dogs and cats*
- *DJ events*

Every evening there is a retro film screening, and on weekends there are even festival-style **ennichi** gatherings.

It becomes clear that WHATAWON was born from a wish to create a place where people of all generations, genders, and physical conditions could feel excited and welcome.

Founders invested **four billion yen of their own capital** into a facility designed for three generations to enjoy together suddenly feels understandable.

And yet, because this place was born from the idea of

“creating what does not yet exist,” no amount of words is truly enough.

One simply has to go and see it for oneself.

Quantum Water, the Healthy Water Used Throughout the Entire Facility!

The name **WHATAWON** is itself a coined phrase, meant to evoke the feeling:

“What a wonderful world!”

It expresses the intention to offer a place that inspires a sense of wonder unlike anything that has come before. The tenants, too, are not ordinary shops or common brands.

Rather, the facility is built around businesses personally selected by its founders, places that offer things genuinely good and not easily found elsewhere.

The owners are a still-young couple in their forties. Their parent company, **antiqua**, develops a broad range of fashion, lifestyle goods, yoga wear, and other brands primarily through online retail.

Their products are characterized by:

- *simple forms with unusual design twists*
- *modern lines*
- *playful maturity*
- *silhouettes and materials carefully chosen to flatter women*

Together, President **Kyoko Hara**, who had already made **Antiqua Tree Café** a success, and her husband, President **Toshiyuki Hara**, undertook this new large-scale project: **WHATAWON**. As parents of three children, they wanted to create a place where children, parents, and grandparents alike could all enjoy themselves together. Even the first exchange of business cards made an impression: instead of a paper card, they offered a web-based digital card, very much in keeping with the spirit of a contemporary venture company.

Payments for parking, dining, and more are all cashless.

In that sense, the facility seems almost to anticipate the style of the Osaka Expo and similar future developments. It is precisely because the Haras possess an open and refined sensitivity that they chose to install a full-scale **Quantum Water System** throughout the entire facility, making it a new model case for the region.

One of the attractions is SOKOTOTO, a public bath facility designed as a “Quantum Water Onsen,” complete with ceramic plate bathing and sauna.

There are also hands-on events where visitors can experience **Quantum Water** directly through a “**palm-sized onsen**” using the **LED + 5.5 Medical Shower**. Quantum Water, water servers have also been installed.

In fact, WHATAWON presents itself openly with the phrase:

“WHATAWON uses body-friendly quantum water!” and explains its effects with such lines as:

“For a body that resists rusting!”

“Patent-certified”

“Experimentally verified”

According to President Hara, the following were effects he personally confirmed through experiments:

- 1. Flowers last up to ten times longer than in tap water***
— suggesting bacteriostatic effects, bacterial control, and freshness retention
- 2. Antioxidant properties***
— contributing to improved immune strength
- 3. Greater penetration and dissolving power***
— improving absorption efficiency of nutrients and oxygen
- 4. Hydrogen generation***
— creating water containing hydrogen capable of reducing active oxygen
- 5. Chlorine neutralization***
— by adding the vG7 activator, chlorine can be reduced by approximately 90% instantly

Originally, the trigger came when someone involved in handling natural and health foods from **Musō** mentioned vG7 Quantum Water.

President Kyoko Hara decided to test its power for herself.

She placed flowers into two vases:

- *one with quantum water*

- *one with tap water*

Shing02, the hip-hop artist whom we had once met together with Wellness President Shuushi Nomura during a visit to the independent Hawaiian kingdom of Waimanalo, where they brought a vG7 Quantum Water device as a gift to former head of state **Bumpy Kanahele**, the seventh in the line of King Kamehameha.

A vG7 Quantum Water device had also been installed at the entrance to Hawaiian independent Waimanalo. We had continued to encounter Shing02 on later visits to Hawai’i, but now, to our surprise, there was a **SEVEN** brand shop in WHATAWON’s shopping area designed by him, and he was scheduled to appear live at the first music festival on **June 22**. It was a surprising connection, and at the same time part of the precious network of Wellness supporters.

What one senses here is not only an ability to keep generating “newness,” but a determination to continue sending fresh values out into the world.

As the facility had only just opened, it was still impossible to grasp its full scope. But there is no doubt that over time, people of all ages will each discover their own way of enjoying it. After all, for a single private company, and a relatively young venture company at that, to create an entertainment mall on this scale is extraordinary.

It puts even major retail giants to shame. And that is why both WHATAWON and the Quantum Water of Wellness remain so full of promise for the future.

The Dream and Wish of a “Sayurist”

To Turn the Pool Yoshinaga Sayuri Uses into a Quantum Water Pool

The Actress Yoshinaga Sayuri Whom I Once Met

Mr. Shuushi Nomura, the developer of vG7 Quantum Water and president of Wellness, is, like many inventors, a romantic at heart. At the foundation of that romanticism lies a love for humanity. Yet the side of him that becomes most openly romantic is revealed in the intensity of his devotion to actress **Sayuri Yoshinaga**, as a true “**Sayurist**.”

On March 13, 2025, Sayuri Yoshinaga reached the age of eighty. It almost seems as though she herself embodies the peaceful eighty years of postwar Japan. She is, in every sense, one of the great national actresses of the postwar era. Because of difficulties caused by her father’s business failure, she entered the entertainment world at the age of eleven. In the radio drama **Akadō Suzunosuke**, she played **Sayuri**, the daughter of the late-Edo sword master **Chiba Shūsaku**. The most famous Sayurist of them all is perhaps the multi-talented entertainer **Tamori**, who left Waseda University before graduating. But among those born around the baby-boom generation, each person has his or her own private memories and stories of “my Sayuri Yoshinaga.” As for me, I remember listening intently to that very radio drama when I was in the fifth or sixth grade, because a classmate of mine was appearing in it as well. And though I would not have described myself as a passionate devotee, the very first celebrity photograph I ever bought, at Marubel-dō in Asakusa, was of Sayuri Yoshinaga in her debut years. In that sense, I too was, naturally enough, a Sayurist. That I later became a journalist was merely coincidence. But once I had become one, I began to ask myself:

What is it I should do?

Whom is it I wish to meet?

One answer was: to meet people I could truly respect.

The other was: ***to meet Sayuri Yoshinaga.***

Respectable people, as it turns out, are not always easy to encounter.

But as for Sayuri Yoshinaga, I did in fact meet her in person during coverage of the 1988 Toho film **Tsuru**, the commemorative 100th film of her career as a leading actress. By profession, I had already met many actresses and beauties.

And yet, when I met Sayuri Yoshinaga, the very first thought that came to mind was this: ***“Even if she were riding the Yamanote Line, she would still somehow be unreachable.”***

She was that fully, unmistakably, **an actress**, a presence so removed from ordinary life that wherever she went, whatever she inhabited, became a stage. She possessed not only unwavering beauty, but also the earnestness and sincerity that seemed wholly natural in her. Compared with Sayuri Yoshinaga, so-called beautiful actresses somehow appeared

diminished. People have long asked, *“Who will be the next Sayuri Yoshinaga?”* But in the end, there has been no one to take her place. And perhaps that is only natural.

To Make the Pool Where Sayuri Yoshinaga Swims into a Quantum Water Pool

Mr. Nomura is, by his own admission and by the admission of others, a devoted Sayurist. Yet until now, the woman who lived beyond the silver screen had existed for him only in films and on television. He had never had the chance to meet her.

When Mr. Nomura learned that I had once met Sayuri Yoshinaga, he looked at me with a mixture of astonishment and envy, as though, by some small measure, I had stepped one pace closer to the possibility of meeting her.

In September 2024, when her husband, TV producer **Taro Okada**, who had been fifteen years her senior, passed away at the age of ninety-four, Mr. Nomura, like many Sayurists, found himself recalling their marriage announcement in June 1973 and reacting with the same indignation as though it had happened only yesterday.

For Sayuri Yoshinaga, who had resolved to live as an actress, Mr. Okada was a choice far beyond what most Sayurists could have imagined. I myself regarded it objectively as a wise decision. But naturally, many Sayurists did not see it that way.

At the time, there was even writing that captured their feelings:

“Of all people, why marry a divorced man fifteen years older?”

The Sayurists went into a panic. With that marriage, their idealized longing was shattered, and what remained, for some, was resentment.

And yet, though people had said, “They’ll surely divorce soon enough,” the two remained together for fifty-one years.

Even if she remains, to most, a figure somewhere among the clouds, the heart of a Sayurist has not changed, then or now.

Mr. Nomura’s work, as the developer of vG7 Quantum Water, is to help make the world healthier and, in his own way, better. Of course, if he were to act solely from personal emotion, the true value of Quantum Water might be compromised. Private feeling, in such matters, must be held in check. And yet the person in question is Sayuri Yoshinaga...the national actress who seems to symbolize the eighty peaceful years of postwar Japan. The health practices that support her life as an actress are said to include the invisible discipline of daily squats and abdominal exercises, the kind of quiet effort required to continue standing on the stage.

And when Mr. Nomura heard that, beginning in her forties, she had made swimming an important part of her life in order to build supple, balanced muscle through whole-body exercise, he says his heart was immediately stirred.

As is well known, swimming pools throughout Japan depend on chlorine disinfection for sanitary reasons. Anyone who has taken swimming lessons in school knows how chlorine can roughen the skin and leave the hair discolored. Unlike in earlier times, people now even need goggles to protect their eyes, a reminder that pools, though intended for health, are not without their disadvantages.

When Mr. Nomura learned that she visited a members-only sports club once a week, he followed every possible lead and at last identified the pool she used. Of course, to simply appear there with a brochure about Quantum Water and data from pools already using the system would only invite suspicion. So instead, he sought an introduction through socially credible intermediaries, a physician, a secretary to a member of parliament, and others, in hopes that someone might at least listen.

His proposal was simple:

If the vG7 Quantum Water system were installed, the harmful effects of chlorine could be reduced, the chlorine odor lessened, chlorine usage itself decreased, and operating costs for the pool lowered as well. And so, for her sake, he offered to provide the equipment free of charge.

It was, by all appearances, a sincere proposal born from a single wish:

to protect Sayuri Yoshinaga's skin, even a little, from the effects of chlorine.

And yet perhaps because the passion of the Sayurist was simply too intense, or because people feared that there must be some ulterior motive, or that the gesture would somehow be used for publicity, the offer was never realized.

Which means that, even now, Mr. Nomura's dream remains exactly as it was. Perhaps one day, he may yet meet Sayuri Yoshinaga and invite her into a pool of Quantum Water. The dream of Mr. Nomura, the Sayurist, goes on still.

Chapter 7 : If It's "Stage 4," Can Cancer Still Be Cured?

More Deaths from Vaccines Than from COVID? More Deaths from Cancer Than from Vaccines?

Reports of Survival from Cancer

COVID Does Not Even Rank Among the Top Ten Causes of Death in Japan

- *In 2020, the leading cause of death among Japanese people was malignant neoplasm (tumors), that is, cancer, with 378,385 deaths.*
- *Second was heart disease (excluding hypertensive heart disease), with 205,596 deaths.*
- *Third was senility, with 132,440 deaths.*
- *Fourth was cerebrovascular disease, with 102,978 deaths.*
- *Fifth was pneumonia, with 78,450 deaths.*

That senility had surpassed cerebrovascular disease, one of the so-called three major diseases, to rank third reflects the realities of an aging society.

Below these came:

- *accidental death: 38,133*
- *kidney failure: 26,948*
- *suicide: 20,243*
- *liver disease: 17,688*
- *diabetes, in tenth place: 13,902*

By contrast, COVID-related deaths totaled roughly 20,000 over two and a half years, which means that COVID did not truly qualify to enter the top ten.

If one looks calmly at the causes of death in Japan, it becomes clear that COVID is not, in fact, the disease we should fear most. There is a reason people have long said that *“a common cold is the beginning of many illnesses”*: because it often becomes the trigger for diseases that many Japanese suffer from, and die from.

In reality, those dying are overwhelmingly people in their sixties and seventies and older. What matters, therefore, is not to fear COVID excessively, but rather to remain healthy enough that, even if infected, one does not carry the kind of underlying conditions that could turn infection into a fatal event.

More Deaths from Vaccines Than from COVID?

During the sixth wave driven by the Omicron variant, Japan caused a great public stir when daily deaths finally rose from around 100 to 200, and the cumulative death toll surpassed 20,000. And yet, after more than two years had passed, two facts stood out clearly.

The first was that Pfizer, the major U.S. pharmaceutical company, reported that its net profit for fiscal year 2021 had increased to roughly 2.4 times that of the previous year.

The second was a striking change in Japan’s official mortality statistics from the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

According to a December 23 article in the *Nikkei*, the number of deaths through September 2021 had increased by **59,810** compared with the previous year.

Even if one assumes that this increase was simply due to COVID, once approximately **12,000 COVID deaths** are subtracted, there still remain about **48,000 excess deaths** whose causes are unclear. That is precisely the point emphasized by attorneys involved in vaccine-related litigation.

No matter how aging Japanese society may be, they argue that an increase in deaths exceeding even that seen during the Great East Japan Earthquake cannot reasonably be explained by anything other than vaccination.

The total number of domestic deaths attributed to COVID since the outbreak has only just exceeded 20,000. Even if vaccine-related deaths were only half that number, they would still easily surpass COVID deaths.

At the same time, what must not be forgotten is this: even beyond COVID deaths or alleged vaccine deaths, the leading cause of death among Japanese people every year remains cancer.

While media-aligned commentators described as “experts” stoked fear over figures such as “more than 150 deaths a day,” the reality is that cancer claims approximately **1,037 lives per day**, while senility claims around **363 per day**.

Of course, not all experts were engaged in amplifying fear over COVID and recommending vaccination. There have also been conscientious physicians who have spoken out about the many contradictions in what unfolded. Among them is Professor Emeritus **Masahiko Okada** of Niigata University, author of **Is the New Vaccine Really Safe?** (KADENSHA), with the subtitle *The Reality of the COVID Vaccine Coming into View*. There is also Dr. **Atsushi Nakamura**, a plaintiff in vaccine litigation, and Dr. **Masayuki Ikeda**, who posted particularly forceful materials on his website. They and others have sought to expose the many problems surrounding both COVID and the vaccines. Those issues are addressed in those books, as well as in **Chapter 9** of this book. Here, however, we turn instead to encouraging reports concerning cancer, a cause of death greater than either COVID or vaccine-related deaths.

Reports of Survival from Cancer

A Report from Ms. Hiromi Higuchi, Director of the Koga Black Ninja Institute

“This Is Incredible!”

Among the many clients known to Dr. Shigenori Uda of the Uda Institute of Technology, one case stood out to him in particular as truly extraordinary. It involved **Ms. Hiromi Higuchi**, director of the **Koga Black Ninja Institute** in Otsu, Shiga Prefecture, which manufactures and sells *black garlic* under the slogan of “boosting immunity.”

On this occasion, I was able to hear directly from Ms. Higuchi herself. What follows is her report.

Case 1: T., a Woman in Her 60s with Breast Cancer

I had been sending “*GuruGuru Water*” (reverse water) to a younger woman from Doshisha University. In May 2018, I also forwarded a **10-liter container** intended for my own use to my younger brother’s home.

At that time, my brother’s wife had been diagnosed with **terminal stage 4 breast cancer**. The tumor had ruptured, and surgery was no longer considered possible. She had become desperate and hopeless, and my brother himself did not know what to do. Still, he told her: “*Just try drinking it.*”

At the time, a treatment plan had already been established, and she was taking anticancer medication. About a week to ten days after beginning the “GuruGuru Water”, the bleeding stopped, and the ruptured tumor began to shrink. The pomegranate-like state of the wound disappeared. The attending physician, upon examining her, reportedly said to the nurse: “I thought this drug was an effective one, but even so... this is working unusually well.” The two apparently looked at each other in surprise. After that, the cancer became operable.

She underwent successful surgery in September and remained hospitalized through the end of the year. Two years later, at New Year, she had entered what is commonly called **remission**. Having received the doctor’s formal approval, the couple celebrated with wine. But after such a long time without alcohol, she became completely intoxicated, a small and touching mishap.

There has been no recurrence since the surgery, and as of the New Year of 2022, she remains in remission. Even now, she continues to drink reverse water.

Case 2: Ta., a Woman in Her 50s with Blood Cancer

The second case involved a farming family in Omihachiman with whom I had long been acquainted. When I spoke to the husband about Quantum Water, he immediately said: *“I want it, absolutely.”*

So in December 2018, we installed **vG7 Quantum Water (New G 1L)** directly after the home’s water meter. We had originally become close through Dr. Uda’s recommended salt-based farming method. On the surface, the discussion was about using it for agriculture. In reality, however, his wife was already in an advanced terminal state with a blood-related cancer.

She had effectively been given a death sentence, and in that darkest period at year’s end, they introduced the system in what could only be described as a last desperate hope. The husband only revealed the full story later, after his wife was discharged from the hospital in 2021 and no longer required anticancer treatment, having entered remission.

While she was hospitalized, he delivered water every day to the hospital, water that had been passed through the Hexagon (vG core) at home.

Now she has recovered, and has returned once again to working in the fields.

Case 3: Mr. M.O. (Male, in His 70s) ... Rectal Cancer

The third case concerns the husband of a former office employee from a company I once managed. In May 2019, he underwent surgery for rectal cancer in the summer, but the cancer had already metastasized, and from autumn through the end of the year,

he underwent surgery to remove liver cancer as well. He had been cultivating a branded variety of bamboo shoots using the salt-application farming method. Soon after the bamboo shoot season ended, he developed rectal cancer. By September, after leaving the hospital, it had already spread to his liver. Following a very serious operation, he returned home for recovery. From the time the cancer was discovered, I continued bringing him water.

However, the side effects from three rounds of chemotherapy were severe. For about ten days after each treatment, although visitors were permitted, he was overcome by exhaustion and nausea, and his hair had begun to fall out.

At that point, I told him:

“This water is meant to help prevent further metastasis and to keep the cancer from growing larger, so please drink it more often, in smaller amounts, throughout the day.”

He continued doing so. Then, in early spring of 2021, I was told that his doctor, while palpating the affected area, said:

“Your liver is doing well. You no longer need chemotherapy.” He was overjoyed, saying, *“Amazing—you can tell just by touching it?”*

He himself does not seem to think,

“The water cured me,”

but now he listens very carefully to what I say. He is no longer able to cultivate bamboo shoots in exactly the same way as before, but he has recovered well, attends local senior gatherings, and lives an otherwise ordinary life.

Case 4: Ms. T.M. (Female, in Her 60s) : Liver Cancer

The fourth case is still ongoing. In September 2020, through an acquaintance, I received an order for black garlic from the chief priest of a temple in Tokyo. His wife had terminal cancer originating in the blood system, and at the time was undergoing care for liver cancer.

Together with the black garlic, I sent 2 liters of reverse water cycled 8,000 times, and instructed them to dilute it fivefold before drinking.

Afterward, they told me she was feeling better, and when they next ordered black garlic, they asked, *“Could we also have that water?”*

So I sent them 10 liters. But since not only his wife, but also their daughter and sons, had begun drinking it, it soon became impossible for me to keep up with the demand.

So in September 2021, they purchased a **vG7 Hexagon 30** system. Since then, his wife’s appetite has returned, she has been able to resume normal daily life, and she has refused chemotherapy. At the end of last year, her husband wrote to me:

“It is hard to believe that this is really a stage 4 liver cancer patient.”

From a 75% Remission Rate Toward 100%

The above records span roughly three years. Of the four cases, three entered **remission**, which suggests an improvement rate of **75%**. If the fourth case also reaches remission, the figure would become **100%**.

And yet, with vG7 Quantum Water, there seems to be a marked difference between those who are somehow “meant to encounter it” and those who are not.

Afterward, at the end of 2021, Ms. Higuchi rushed to send water to three more people. Two of them passed away. She says she does not know whether it was already too late, or whether they had really been drinking it properly. One of those who passed away was a former subordinate of her younger brother, who had liver cancer. He was somewhat stubborn man, and in the end, they lost contact before he died. The other was a friend of the farmer’s wife who had previously gone into remission from blood cancer. Her cancer had already spread extensively. ***“I told her to drink the water, but I truly don’t know if she did. She died less than three months after I sent it.”***

Faced with such painful outcomes, Ms. Higuchi admits that in the beginning, even when people said, ***“The cancer was cured...”*** her own feeling had been, ***“Could water like this really work?”*** So she can hardly criticize others for doubting.

And yet, having now witnessed many astonishing cases, she says:

“I believe in it completely now. These days, I feel, ‘I’m going to help heal this person with this water!’ ” Though she has not yet reached the more than one hundred clients of Dr. Uda, she hopes to reach at least half that number, and continues energetically promoting reverse water alongside her black garlic.

Along with Dr. Uda, she has become one of Wellness’s strongest allies.

The Wellness website also presents many video recordings of actual sites and firsthand testimonies. As with all things: ***Seeing is believing.***

“Why Do We Make Such Needless Effort?”

On the Merits and Burdens of Futile Effort

Diffuse Large B-Cell Lymphoma : Entered Remission

Eliminating the Unnecessary, While Illness Runs Deep

The other day, an acquaintance told me that he had gone to meet the wife of a once-famous postwar Supreme Court justice. She is already over ninety years old, and according to him, her husband had always told her:

“Do not watch newspapers or television. The truth of what is happening in the world is not written there.”

I thought: Indeed. If one looks squarely at the world, one sees something long pointed out in macrobiotic circles, among others: doctors and medicines increased, hospitals and pharmaceutical companies profited, and as a result, both diseases and patients increased as well.

There was once, in America, a hospital strike. During that period, something unexpected happened: ***both illness and deaths from illness actually decreased.***

Doctors and hospitals, medicines and pharmaceutical companies, had all increased, but the number of illnesses and the sick had increased even more.

In short, it is certainly true that there are people who need doctors and medicine. But the world is not arranged solely according to human convenience. So then, without relying on medicine more than necessary, how are we to regain health in daily life?

Lymphoma : Entered Remission

Recently, I often hear of people developing what is commonly referred to as a “blood cancer”, **lymphoma**.

Many concrete cases and testimonies are introduced in *vG7 Quantum Water* (Hikaruland), and among them are cases involving lymphoma.

Because of space limitations, the descriptions in the book are brief. So in order to provide a clearer picture, I would like to present in greater detail two testimonies below, one concerning lymphoma and the other esophageal cancer.

The first is an email sent to Wellness President Shuushi Nomura on **May 24, 2019**. It reports **remission** from **diffuse large B-cell lymphoma**.

Testimony: “My Mother’s Diffuse Large B-Cell Lymphoma Went Into Remission”

Because we undertook a number of things in combination, including changes to diet and other practices thought to benefit the body, I am not sure how useful this will be as a reference, but I would like to report it.

First, my mother’s diagnosis was **diffuse large B-cell lymphoma**.

As for the severity, we were told it was somewhere between level 2 and 3. It was discovered by examination around July of last year. She began using *Reverse Water* in September. And in February of this year, she entered remission.

What we did thoroughly

Our home water purifier is a reverse-osmosis type. Because I had heard that RO water is not suited to *vG7 Quantum Water*, we added liquid minerals before using it.

We always added reverse water (cycled for two to three hours) to her **20-liter bath**. (*We also used it together with a natural ion bath system called SEV Ionizer 705, which sends natural ions into the bathtub.*)

She bathed **twice a day**, morning and afternoon, and each time remained in the bath for at least one hour. Whenever she bathed, we always had her drink *Reverse Water* (preferably water that had been cycled for as long as possible) within a comfortable and

manageable range. (This reverse water had been placed on an SEV Water Plate for at least 15 minutes.)

Beyond that, for drinking water, cooking, and rice preparation, we used only **Reverse Water** that had been placed on the SEV plate. That is what we pursued thoroughly.

Thank you very much for introducing us to **Reverse Water**.

This is, indeed, what Wellness users often refer to as a Quantum Water Onsen a Wellness Onsen.

Another Testimony: Progress Report on Esophageal Cancer

The second testimony is an email received on **August 27, 2019**. It concerns the progress of a case of **esophageal cancer**.

On Friday, we went to Komagome Hospital for a second opinion. In a word, the doctor said: ***“As treatment for the cancer itself, there is really nothing that can be done.”***

Looking at the CT images, he explained everything in detail.

Besides the cancer, there was severe arteriosclerosis, particularly in the aorta.

That alone, he said, was already extremely dangerous. Furthermore, the kidneys were badly weakened, the lungs were almost completely white, and lymph node metastasis had spread all around the body. It was the kind of condition that made one wonder how she had managed to survive this long. Because of that, she was not physically strong enough to withstand radiation or chemotherapy, and we were told that attempting those treatments now could be fatal.

That said, the doctor had not abandoned her. He said that the first priority was to widen the narrowing in the esophagus so that she could eat again.

If that became possible, then localized radiation treatment might later be considered.

That was the LINE message from August 5.

And then, about what happened afterward with my mother.

At the end of July, you sent us the ***“miracle water.”***

First, we gave her one bottle.

Then on August 1, the **Reverse Water Unit** arrived, and from that point on she began drinking it every day.

At first, she could not drink much in quantity. But once she was hospitalized and placed on liquid meals, her strength gradually began to return, and little by little the amount she could drink increased.

Then, on August 8, she was transferred to Komagome Hospital, and instead of liquid meals, she was served actual side dishes together with soft rice porridge.

Not only soft foods, but even leafy greens such as komatsuna, or noodles, foods that made us think ***“won’t that get stuck?”***, were included.

Yet the change in menu stimulated her appetite, and although the portions were not large to begin with, she became able to finish everything except the porridge.

During her hospitalization, nothing was being done other than IV fluids, tests, and basic physical management. After that, there was only occasional inhalation using a hydrogen bottle, and even that was not done consistently.

Then, on August 16, she underwent a second contrast CT scan. The explanation came on the 18th. The first CT had been taken at the previous hospital on July 30, and the second was taken a little more than two weeks later.

The radiologist reportedly said: “Are these really scans of the same person?” I too was shown the CT images and the explanation.

Previously, the opening in her esophagus had been little more than a pinpoint, but now there was a space that looked almost normal. In the newly taken endoscopic images, they said: *“There is certainly cancer in the esophagus, but strangely enough, it is not an emergency.”*

On the barium study as well, they said that it was flowing normally from the esophagus to the stomach. What had appeared as swelling both inside and outside the esophagus was now considered to have been inflammation, and my husband also said that if it was inflammation, then improvement in a short time would indeed be possible.

The attending doctor, too, after first seeing my mother based only on the earlier hospital’s data, had apparently wondered, from the way she was eating,

“What is going on here?”

Still, while this was a great joy, if the esophagus was not the primary site, then there must be cancer elsewhere, and according to the materials, pancreatic cancer had become a possibility. *But in any case, the disappearance of the esophageal narrowing can only be explained by the effect of the water.*

That was what my father, my husband, and I all believed after hearing the doctor’s explanation.

This has become rather long, so I will report the rest another time, but in any case, it is thanks to the water. Thank you, F., for telling us about it.

A Brain Tumor Disappeared with Quantum Water and the “Shinsei” Plate!

The “Shinsei” plate and quantum water are extraordinary. There is only gratitude.

In May 2025, an email was forwarded by Mr. Shuushi Nomura, president of Wellness Co., Ltd.

It read as follows:

“As for the Shinsei Plate, from the very moment I held it in my hand, I could feel an intense tingling vibrational energy coming through it. I knew at once that this was no ordinary thing, so I kept it against my head inside a knit cap all day long.

I even took it into the bath with me, turning the bath into a kind of vibrational bath. I also kept it against my head while sleeping.

*From the beginning, I had sharp, prickling pains here and there in my head from the brain tumor, but those pains disappeared!
After some time, I underwent an MRI of the brain, and the tumor was gone!!*

*The Shinsei Plate is truly extraordinary.
I wanted Ms. Hiroko to know. I was astonished that one large tumor and more than ten smaller ones had disappeared. Thank you so very much.”*

This excited message came from **Ms. Y**, a patternmaker living in Nagoya. The “Hiroko” referred to here is **Ms. Hiroko Hirayama**, President and Representative Director of **Atalie Co., Ltd.**, the fourth-generation successor to the founder of the Yamawaki Academy of Dressmaking and Design. (see Chapter 8).

Known as a devoted supporter of quantum water, Ms. Hirayama often receives grateful messages from friends and acquaintances to whom she has introduced it. This message from Ms. Y was one such example. But the claim that a brain tumor had disappeared through use of the *Shinsei Plate* was particularly remarkable. Because the details were still unclear, we hoped to present the story properly through **Wellness Times**, and so I asked Ms. Hirayama whether a direct interview might be possible.

A Testimony Shared Over Video Call

Whenever I send her a message, she usually replies before very long. Since my request was simply whether I might visit Ms. Y on the way to Osaka, it should have been no more than a matter of YES or NO. I was wondering what to make of the silence when Ms. Hirayama explained that, with Ms. Y, “sometimes she replies immediately, and sometimes, depending on her condition, there is no reply for quite some time.” That made me somewhat concerned.

Then, on June 11, when I visited **Atalie** in Minami-Aoyama, we happened to receive word from Ms. Y herself that she would be able to speak with us for a short time. It became an unexpected interview. We asked about how she had used the *Shinsei Plate*, and about the circumstances under which her brain tumor had disappeared. Seen through the video screen, she looked so lively that it was hard to believe she was still going in and out of hospitals. Ms. Hirayama, who had long known her in her work as a patternmaker, described her as someone she could rely on “almost like an older sister,” even though Ms. Y, at forty-three, was actually more than ten years younger than she was. *Ms. Hirayama said she was simply grateful that Ms. Y had been able to trust both Quantum Water and the Shinsei Plate so wholeheartedly.*

From Brain Tumors to Rehabilitation

Ms. Y had originally begun drinking *Quantum Water* because of **lung cancer** and **brain tumors**.

In July 2023, she underwent **CyberKnife** radiation treatment and had **seven brain tumors** removed.

As a result, her brain function was impaired, and her memory declined dramatically. She said that when she first began rehabilitation, it was difficult even to remember three simple objects:

a pencil, a notebook, and an eraser.

Though she was a patternmaker by profession, there was even a time when folding clothes felt too complicated to manage. Little by little, however, she recovered enough to return to work. She gradually increased the amount of work she could do, and by the time she was discharged in December of that year, she had stopped chemotherapy and was living an ordinary life while continuing to drink Quantum Water.

In 2024, she traveled to places such as **Odawara** and **Yugawara**, and even as far as **Tasmania** and **Hawai'i**.

She said:

“The GuruGuru water (reverse water) was so easy to drink, and I just felt, ‘This is good,’ so I kept drinking it.”

Even so, perhaps for someone living with cancer, she had pushed herself rather too far. She returned to old habits, sweets made with sugar, alcohol, and the kind of diet she had enjoyed before. As a result, her condition worsened, and in September she collapsed and was hospitalized.

Saved by the Shinsei Plate

At the hospital, she was told that her brain was swollen. She received intravenous treatment to reduce the edema, but she had lost even the will to fight, and it would not have been surprising had she died. She was advised to undergo both chemotherapy and whole-brain radiation, and when she did, her memory worsened, and she could no longer walk straight.

And yet, even during hospitalization, she continued to drink only one thing consistently: **Quantum Water (reverse water)**

Then, after being discharged, she visited Atalie in April 2025 and took the *Shinsei Plate* into her hands. She says that at once she could feel a powerful tingling energy.

“I knew this was no ordinary thing, so I put it inside my hat. By the very next day, the prickling, throbbing headaches were gone. After that, MRI scans showed that the tumors had disappeared. At the same time, I have also been doing chemotherapy and dietary therapy.”

She then added the following:

In her dietary treatment, she eliminated the so-called **five poisons**:

- **sugar**
- **wheat flour**
- **dairy products**

- oils
- sweets

She also stopped eating raw foods, making sure instead that everything was cooked through. After reading a book that claimed microorganisms were a cause of cancer, she also began taking herbs and supplements. Her current anticancer drug is a **molecularly targeted therapy**, which she says causes less systemic harm and allows her to remain active. However, her earlier rounds of chemotherapy had damaged her veins so badly that her body seemed to cry out,

“I don’t want to do this anymore.” For that reason, she declined further treatment. She said that with natural healing power and the Shinsei Plate, she felt she could continue living. At present, she is living without ongoing treatment. She uses the Shinsei Plate while sleeping and even in the bath. She also remarked that the larger 72-array type seems to feel the most balanced.

Affinity with the Shinsei Plate

By nature, Ms. Y has always been extremely sensitive. She says she feels things, sometimes even sees things, more keenly than most people do.

It seems likely that she was especially compatible with both Quantum Water and the *Shinsei Plate*.

As with all energy products, effects differ from person to person. Indeed, in her own case, when she tried wrapping printed cloth bearing the word *Shinsei* around her abdomen, the energy felt too strong, and she became unwell. She suggested that perhaps it might be better to cut such material into smaller pieces before use.

Though Ms. Y regained her health through Quantum Water and the *Shinsei Plate*, there is also deep sorrow in her story.

In May 2025, her **53-year-old brother** died from **lung cancer** and **brain tumors**. He had also been drinking Quantum Water, but when she tried to give him a *Shinsei Plate*, seeing how much he was suffering, he said: *“I don’t want to do anything anymore,”* and refused it.

Her older sister had also experienced breast cancer and has already undergone surgery. Their father died ten years ago, and now her brother, sister, and she herself have all suffered from cancer. Watching her children one after another be stricken with cancer while she herself remained untouched, their mother came to feel that it must somehow be her fault.

It seems that she slipped into a mildly depressive state. That mother, too, began drinking Quantum Water, and her depression improved.

Then, after Ms. Y collapsed and was hospitalized, something seemed to switch on again within her mother. She became active once more, began driving again, and now takes her daughter to the hospital herself.
